Inside The Numbers

Rozicki models his aggressive, offense-first style after 1920s heavyweight legend Jack Dempsey, and he backed it up tonight — averaging 47 power punches thrown per round. The volume was there, but the accuracy wasn't. He threw 327 power shots and landed 115, while Billam-Smith threw 117 fewer and still out-landed him, connecting on 121 at a remarkable 58% clip — picking him off cleanly as Rozicki came cascading in.

Billam-Smith's jab was a key weapon, landing 33 to Rozicki's 6 and serving as a consistent rangefinder that kept Rozicki on the end of his punches. Despite being docked a point in the second round for using his head as a weapon, Rozicki never took a backward step, absorbing Billam-Smith's best combinations without retreating and out-landing Billam-Smith 39-26 to the body.

Rozicki had his moments. He found his best stretch mid-fight, and in the seventh — his final round — he actually out-landed Billam-Smith in total punches and matched him in power shots, still coming forward right up until the stoppage. But Billam-Smith had already done his most decisive work. After a quiet fifth round, he erupted in the sixth — his best of the fight — connecting on 28 of 45 power shots at 62% and appearing to take the steam out of Rozicki's attack for good.

Billam-Smith didn't wilt down the stretch. He kept belting away until the referee had seen enough, stepping in to halt the bout before the start of the eighth.
