Inside The Numbers

Cruz was dominant from the opening bell, out-landing Montoya 63-16 over the course of two and a half rounds. Working behind a relentless body attack, Cruz landed 24 shots downstairs in the first two rounds alone, 14 in the first and 10 in the second, softening Montoya before finishing him off. A right hook sent Montoya to the canvas in the closing seconds of round two. Montoya beat the count, but Cruz swarmed him at the start of the third, leaving the referee no choice but to stop the bout at the 54-second mark.

Cruz connected on 63 of 141 attempts (45%) for the fight. Montoya, who was on the back foot throughout, landed just 16 of 97 throws (16%).
